### HELENA VON KREUTER SEMINARIAN SCHOLARSHIP

#### RULES OF ELIGIBILITY AND PROCEDURES

1. Each year, St. Gregory's Episcopal Church offers a limited number of scholarships for tuition, room and board to Episcopal/Anglican seminarians studying for the priesthood or diaconate. Recipients can reapply for each succeeding year up to a maximum of three years upon certification of continuing study/enrollment at an accredited seminary.
2. Any applicant, with appropriate Episcopal/Anglican ecclesiastical approval for entry into Holy Orders, having been accepted at a seminary, is eligible to apply.
3. Preference will be given, although not exclusively, to members of St. Gregory's Episcopal Church in Boca Raton, candidates from the Diocese of Southeast Florida who have been recommended by the Bishop or the Bishop's staff, and candidates from the Diocese of Southeast Florida's companion dioceses.
4. The applicant must complete the application form. All communication with St. Gregory's Episcopal Church is confidential.
5. The Helena Von Kreuter Seminarian Scholarship is awarded based on academic merit and/or financial need. To apply for this scholarship, the applicant must provide a copy of his/her current and complete academic transcript, if applicable, indicating the cumulative GPA.
6. The grant will be sent directly to the seminary for each semester. The seminary must send St. Gregory's proof of the recipient's acceptance or continued enrollment.
7. The applicant will be informed by St. Gregory's that a scholarship has been granted by August 9, 2016.
8. A completed application and supporting materials must be received by July 15, 2016 to be considered for a scholarship. Send to: St. Gregory's Episcopal Church, Attn: Von Kreuter Scholarship, PO Box 1503, Boca Raton, FL, 33429.
